The Fast Break

At a Glance: Tonight, Reno looks to sweep Utah in a back-to-back for the second time this season (also 11/20-21 in Reno)...seven of Reno's next nine games will be played away from Reno...the Bighorns sit in a tie for second place in the Western Conference with Bakersfield...tonight is Reno's final game before heading to the D-League Showcase next week.

All-Time Series: Tonight's epic battle marks the 20th all-time meeting between the Bighorns and **Flash Fox's Utah Flash**...Reno holds the all-time edge, 11-8...last season, the two teams met ten times, with the 'Horns taking 6-of-10...was the most games against a single opponent for both teams...Reno and Utah square off seven more times this season...the 20 meetings between the two teams marks the most all-time for Reno against a single opponent...Reno has won three-straight games against the Flash, and two-straight in Orem.

Getting Defensive: Last night, Reno allowed its lowest point total of the season (82)...was the fifth time this season that Reno has held an opponent under 90 points (5-0)...was also the sixth time in the last eight games that Reno has held an opponent to 100 points or fewer (4-4)...the Bighorns currently sit fourth in the league in opponents' PPG (100.6)...last night also marked the fifth time this season that the opposing team has not had a player record 20 or more points in a game (4-1).

Sloan to the Rescue: Last night marked the first game this season that **G Aaron Miles** did not start at point guard...Miles was waived due to injury on Thursday after suffering a knee injury in Wednesday's loss to Iowa...**G Donald Sloan** earned the nod at the 'one' last night, leading the Bighorns with a season-high 20 points...Sloan also set a season-high by playing 38 minutes...Sloan's previous season-highs had been 14 points and 30 minutes...both previous season-highs had been set on opening night vs. UTA (11/20).

Banging the Boards: **F Patrick Ewing, Jr.** set a new team-season-high with 14 rebounds last night...previous team-season-high was 13 rebounds (Fazekas, 3x; Charlo)...marked Ewing's sixth double-digit rebounding effort this season, as well as his sixth double-double...on 12/10 vs. RGV, Ewing, Jr. recorded the 'Horns' lone triple-double this season (26 points, 10 rebounds, 11 assists).

Nothing in Life is Free: Reno won the free-throw battle last night, attempting 42 foul shots to Utah's 18...the 'Horns connected on 32-42 from the charity stripe, while the Flash managed to shoot just 12-18 from the line...Reno has out-shot its opponent from the free throw line in 14-of-18 games this season...the 'Horns are 11-3 when shooting more free throws than their opponent (0-4 when out-shot by opponent).

Biggest Little Notes in the World: Reno committed a season-low 11 turnovers last night...improved to 10-1 when committing fewer turnovers than their opponent (1-6 when losing the turnover battle)...the Bighorns won last night despite shooting just 39.0% from the field, their worst output of the season...last night, **G Donald Sloan** became the seventh different Bighorn to lead the team in scoring.

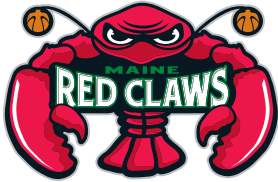

OREM, Utah—Patrick Ewing, Jr.'s sixth double-double propelled the Reno Bighorns to a 95-82 win over the Utah Flash Friday night in the UCCU Events Center.

With the game tied 59-59 entering the fourth quarter, Reno would outscore Utah 36=23 in the final frame to grab their third road win of the year, and third-straight victory over the Flash.

In a game that saw 14 lead changes and 10 ties, the Bighorns pulled away late behind Ewing's strong night. The forward from Georgetown netted 18 points and grabbed a team-season-high 14 rebounds. Donald Sloan led the Bighorns in scoring with 20 points in just his second start of the season, and first as Aaron Miles' replacement as Reno's point guard.

D.J. Strawberry chipped in with 19 points and six boards off the bench. Reno earned the victory despite shooting just 39.0% from the field and getting out rebounded 50-47.

Orien Greene led Utah with 19 points, while Brandon Costner added 15 points off the bench, including connecting on 3-6 from behind the three-point stripe.
