The Fast Break

At a Glance: Today, the Bighorns look to extend their season-opening three-game winning streak in the second game of a back-to-back against Bakersfield...this is the first 3-0 start in franchise history for Reno, and also the first time the 'Horns have ever been in first place...Reno, New Mexico (2-0) and Iowa (4-0) are the last remaining unbeaten teams in the D-League.

All-Time Series: Today's epic battle marks the 11th all-time meeting between the Bighorns and Tim DiFrancesco's Bakersfield Jam...Reno holds the all-time series lead, 6-4...Reno is 5-1 all-time against Bakersfield at home, including winning five-straight games in Reno dating back to 1/10/09...the two clubs face each other 6 more times this season, with 4 of the 6 games to be played in Reno.

Home Sweet Home: Dating back to last season, Reno has now won eight-straight regular season home games...only two of Reno's eight wins have been by single digits, with the average margin of victory being 12.5 points per game...the Bighorns have scored 100+ points in seven of their eight wins...the 'Horns are 36-17 (.679) all time at home.

Spread the Wealth: Reno is one of only three teams in the league that have seven players averaging at least 10 ppg (also Rio Grande Valley, Texas)...Patrick Ewing, Jr., Mo Charlo, Marcus Landry, Nick Fazekas, D.J. Strawberry, Aaron Miles and Donald Sloan are all averaging double figures, with Ewing, Jr. leading the charge (21.0 ppg)...the Bighorns have had one game each with five, six and seven players scoring in double figures...no player has eclipsed the 30-point plateau in a game this season.

Lucky Number Thirteen: In last night's game, **G Aaron Miles** dished out 13 assists for the second time in three games...Miles, the all-time assists leader in Big 12 history, is leading the league in assists (10.3 apg) after three games, despite being ejected in the second quarter of last Sunday's game...Miles' 31 total assists also leads the league...the all-time single-game Bighorns record for assists in a game is 14, held by David Noel (4/4/09) and Will Blalock (3/13/10).

Leading the Loop: Entering tonight's game, the 'Horns sit in the top 3 in the league in five different statistical categories...Reno leads the league in free throws made (103) and free throws attempted (142)...it also leads the league with 34 steals...Reno is currently second in the league with 72 assists, and third in the league in three-point field goal percentage (41.5%).

Biggest Little Notes in the World: **F Mo Charlo** enters today's game second in the league in FG% (72.0%) and three-point FG% (71.4%)...after tonight, Reno plays host to Idaho this Wednesday at 11 a.m. before hitting the road for its first road trip of the season (Dakota and Sioux Falls)...Reno has recorded more assists than its opponent in all three games this season...Bakersfield G Trey Johnson attempted 22 field goals last night, the most by an opposing player this season.

RENO, Nev.—DJ Strawberry marked his return to Reno with 14 points and five boards Friday afternoon, helping lift the Bighorns to a 105-90 victory over the Bakersfield Jam in the Reno Events Center.

Strawberry, who starred for Reno last season, was added to the Bighorns roster on Thursday and registered 22 minutes off the bench in his season debut. The guard out of Maryland was one of seven Bighorns to finish in double-figures in scoring on the day.

The Jam slowed the Bighorns out of the gate, but Reno outscored Bakersfield by 16 points in the second period and never looked back, cruising to their third-straight victory. The Bighorns stay perfect on the season and hold their perch atop the Western Conference standings.

Patrick Ewing, Jr. led the 'Horns with 20 points and nine rebounds on the day. Aaron Miles recorded 13 assists to complement 13 points, while Mo Charlo finished with 14 points, three steals and three blocked shots. Marcus Landry knocked-down three three-point tries on his way to 16 points.

Bakersfield was led by 27 points from Trey Johnson, who shot 10-of-22 from the field. Brandon Wallace grabbed a game-high 12 rebounds for the Jam, who outrebounded Reno 50-40 on the afternoon.
