The Fast Break

At a Glance: Today, the Bighorns look to extend their season-opening four-game winning streak in a special 11 a.m. game against the Idaho Stampede...this is the first 4-0 start in franchise history for Reno...Reno is now the last remaining unbeaten team in the NBA Development League...after today's game, the Bighorns hit the road for a Friday-Saturday back-to-back against Dakota and Sioux Falls.

All-Time Series: Today's epic battle marks the 15th all-time meeting between the Bighorns and Joel Abelson's Idaho Stampede...Idaho holds the all-time series lead, 9-5...Reno dropped 5-of-8 to Idaho during the 2009-10 campaign, including the first four meetings of the season...the two clubs face each other four more times this season, with 3 of the 5 games to be played in Reno.

Welcome, Young Whiteside: Earlier this week, Sacramento Kings **C Hassan Whiteside** was assigned to the Bighorns...is the second NBA assignment in franchise history (also Donte Greene, 08-09)...the 7-footer averaged 5.4 blocks per game at Marshall last season, and was named Conference USA Defensive Player of the Year and C-USA Freshman of the Year...Whiteside was taken with the 33rd overall pick in 2010 NBA Draft.

Holding Onto the Rock: Reno has the third-best turnover margin in the D-League this season...the Bighorns have forced 21 more turnovers than they've committed (80-59)...only Dakota and Tulsa (+25 each) have a better turnover margin than the 'Horns...Reno has had a "plus" turnover margin in each of its four games this season.

Dishin' Double-Digit Dimes: Last Saturday, **G Aaron Miles** dished out 12 assists...was the third game this season he has recorded at least 12 assists...is leading the league in assists (10.8 apg) after four games, despite being ejected in the second quarter of the game on 11/21...Miles' 43 total assists also leads the league...nobody else in the league has more than 31 assists (Curtis Stinson, IOW)...the all-time single-game Bighorns record for assists in a game is 14, held by David Noel (4/4/09) and Will Blalock (3/13/10)...so far this season, Miles has accounted for 47.3% of the Bighorns' total assists.

'Horns Getting Hacked: Entering tonight's game, the 'Horns lead the D-League in free throws attempted per game (44.5 FTA per game)...Reno has shot more free throws than their opponents in all four games so far this season...Reno has out-shot its opponents 178-114 from the charity stripe this season...**F Patrick Ewing, Jr.** is second in the league in FTA with 46 (1st: Othuyus Jeffers, IOW, 54)...on 11/21 vs. UTA, Reno attempted 58 free throws, marking the fifth-highest single-game total in the history of the D-League.

Biggest Little Notes in the World: **F Mo Charlo** is currently 4th in the league in steals per game (2.3) and 6th in the league in FG% (.625)...Reno is one of three teams in the league that have yet to play a road game (Ft. Wayne, Idaho)...Reno is ranked first in the latest version of the official NBA D-League power rankings.

RENO, Nev.—All five Reno starters finished in double figures Saturday night, as the Bighorns clawed their way to a 91-85 victory over the Bakersfield Jam in the Reno Events Center.

The victory completes a weekend sweep for Reno over the Jam, and improves the Bighorns to 4-0 on the young season. Reno is now the lone undefeated team in the NBA Development League.

Aaron Miles led the way for the Bighorns with 20 points and 12 assists. Nick Fazekas and Patrick Ewing, Jr. each chipped in a double-double effort for Reno on the night. The Bighorns shot 15.4 percent (2-of-13) from the three-point range and 69.4 percent (25-of-36) from the charity stripe.

Bakersfield was paced by a 24-point effort from Trey Johnson, who connected on 10-of-18 tries from the field. Brandon Wallace knocked down four three-point attempts on his way to 17 points.

Reno was dominant in the paint on Saturday, outscoring the Jam 46-30. The Bighorns were also successful in the transition game, scoring 17 fast-break points.
