## The Fast Break

**At a Glance:** Today, the Bighorns look to snap a short 2-game losing skid in their second-straight affair with the Idaho Stampede...Reno is currently mired in its 3rd 2-game losing streak of the season...the Bighorns have not lost 3-straight games since dropping 11 straight last season (12/3-1/2)...Reno included 5 double-figure scorers Friday, and featured 2 players with double-digit rebounds.

**All-Time Series:** Tonight's titanic struggle marks the 10th all-time meeting between the Bighorns and Jinny Giery's Idaho Stampede...Idaho leads the all-time series 7-2...tonight's game is the 4th of 8 meetings between the two squads this season...Idaho has won all 3 games over Reno this season...the Stampede have won 4-straight overall vs. the Bighorns and 6-of-7...**G Russell Robinson** has averaged 17.1 points in 9-career games vs. Idaho.

**Breakout Bighorns:** Friday's game featured a career-night for a pair of young Reno guards...**G Chris Davis**, who is playing in his first professional season, came off the bench to score 15 points with 3 rebounds, an assist, a steal and a block...his points, minutes (24) and rebounds were all new career-highs...Davis had scored 11 points total over the first 11 games of the season...he had played double-digit minutes just twice before Friday, topping out at 13 (12/18 at SF)...he hadn't attempted a free throw this season before going 4-for-4 from the stripe on Friday...**G Eric Devendorf** scored 11 points off the bench Friday in his 3rd-career professional game...had combined for 3 points over his first 2-career games.

**Today's Moves:** Prior to today's game, **G Desmon Farmer** was re-activated after sitting out Friday's game with an injury...to make room on the roster, Reno has waived **G Dave Noel** due to injury.

**Success from the Stripe:** **G Desmon Farmer** has made 42-straight free-throw attempts, with his last miss coming on 12/13 vs. BAK...has hit 73 of his last 78 attempts (93.6 percent)...is shooting 88.9 percent from the line on the season (80-of-90)...is ranked 3rd all-time in the D-League with 537-career free throws made...is a career 76.8 percent free-throw shooter in the D-League...Farmer is on pace to make 363 free throws this season, which would top the all-time single-season mark set by Will Conroy (323, 08-09 with ABQ).

**On Pace for Greatness:** **G Desmon Farmer** has continued a steady climb up the NBA D-League's all-time scoring list...after starting the season 5th all-time, he has crept up the leaderboard and now sits in 3rd place...Farmer's 2,521 career points are 36 fewer than Maine's Billy Thomas and 261 fewer than all-time leader Will Conroy, who signed a contract with Rio Grande Valley last Wednesday.

**Biggest Little Notes in the World:** Reno's next 2 games will be played in Boise, Idaho, as part of the 2010 NBA D-League Showcase...the Bighorns will play Dakota on Monday and face Erie on Wednesday, resting on Tuesday to celebrate the 28th birthday of assistant coach and video coordinator extraordinaire **Tom Bialaszewski**.

## reno bighorns gameday information

RENO, Nev.— Patty Mills, on assignment from the Portland Trail Blazers, scored 38 points off the Idaho bench Friday night, lifting the Stampede to a 123-109 New Year's Day victory over the Reno Bighorns in the Reno Events Center.

Mills, Portland's second-round draft pick out of St. Mary's, finished 7-of-10 from behind the arc, while also chipping in 12 assists. Anthony Tolliver, who was waived by the Trail Blazers just days ago, scored 30 points and pulled down 12 rebounds for the Stampede (7-5).

Russell Robinson led the way for Reno (5-7) with 20 points and five assists. Marcus Hubbard recorded a double-double with 13 points and 13 rebounds on the evening for the Bighorns.

The night also included a coming-out party of sorts for a pair of young Reno guards. Eric Devendorf, in his third game with Reno, scored 11 points, while Chris Davis had a career night with 15 points off the bench.

The Bighorns outrebounded the Stampede 51-43. Idaho's proficiency from three-point range, though, proved to be the difference. The Stampede shot 46.9 percent from beyond the arc, hitting 15-of-32 attempts. Reno was limited to just two three-point field goals in 10 attempts.
