## The Fast Break

**At a Glance:** Tonight, the Bighorns look to get back on the winning track after having their 4-game winning streak snapped last Friday at Utah...despite losing last Friday, Reno topped the 100-point plateau for the 4th-straight game...the loss dropped the Bighorns to 2-5 in the 2nd of back-to-back games against the same opponent...tonight the Bighorns celebrate Breast Cancer Awareness Night...pink and white Bighorns t-shirts are being sold, with proceeds to benefit Susan G. Komen for the Cure.

**All-Time Series:** Tonight's titanic struggle marks the 12th all-time meeting between the Bighorns and Drew Sellers' Utah Flash...Utah leads the all-time series 6-5...Reno has taken 3-of-5 against the Flash this season...tonight's game marks the 6th of 10 scheduled matchups between the 2 teams...the 10 games against Utah are the most the Bighorns will play against any other opponent...the 2 teams square-off 6 times in the month of January alone...Reno is 3-1 all-time against Utah in the Reno Events Center.

**Get to the Point:** Prior to tonight's game, the Bighorns acquired **G Will Blalock** from Maine in exchange for G Russell Robinson...Blalock averaged 8.5 points and 5.6 assists per game for the Red Claws...played in 14 games with the Detroit Pistons in the 2006-07 season...Robinson played in 72 games over the last 2 seasons with Reno.

**Joining the Herd:** This morning, the Bighorns officially acquired **G DJ Strawberry** and **F DeWitt Scott**...the pair takes the roster spots vacated by **G Majic Dorsey** and **G Dave Noel**, who were both waived due to injury...Strawberry will wear No. 23 tonight...Scott will wear No. 14...Strawberry had a standout career at Maryland before being selected by the Phoenix Suns with the 59th overall pick in the 2007 NBA Draft...he played in 34 games with the Suns that season...Scott began this season with Fort Wayne, averaging 3.3 points, 1.2 boards and 0.4 assists per game for the Mad Ants.

**Start Me Up:** Since 1/8, **F Doug Thomas** has started all 7 games for the Bighorns...had not started a game all season before 1/8...is averaging 9.6 rebounds per game as a starter (5.8 rebounds per game coming off the bench)...has recorded 8+ rebounds in 6-of-7 games as a starter, including 3 10+ rebound performances...pulled down a season-high 16 boards on 1/15 at IDA...has 2 double-doubles in his last 4 games (0 double-doubles in 1st 16 games).

**Home Cookin':** Tonight's game is Reno's 1st home game since 1/12, and only its 2nd home game in the last 26 days...the Bighorns are currently 4-4 at home, 5-7 on the road and 0-2 on a neutral floor...after this weekend's games, Reno hits the road again, playing 8 of its next 10 games away from Reno...12 of Reno's final 16 games will be played at home (2/27-4/3)...**G Desmon Farmer** averages 27.5 ppg at home (23.1 ppg on the road)...as a team, the Bighorns score 104.4 ppg at home, compared with 102.8 ppg on the road.

**Biggest Little Notes in the World:** **F Yaroslav Korolev** made his Reno debut last Wednesday night in Utah (1/20), scoring 2 points with 4 rebounds and a block in 20 minutes off the bench...was acquired by the Bighorns on 1/19 in a trade with Albuquerque, in exchange for F Marcus Hubbard...the Bighorns are playing their first game in 8 days, their longest stretch between games this season.

**OREM, Utah**—Reno saw a three-point halftime lead dissipate in the second half Friday night, as the Utah Flash edged the Bighorns 109-104 in the McKay Events Center. The loss snaps a four-game winning streak for the Bighorns.

The Bighorns (9-13) trailed in the early-going, but fired back in the second quarter. Reno allowed just 16 points in the second period, as the Bighorns to a three-point advantage into the locker room. In the third quarter, the Flash (14-11) came to life, outscoring Reno by 12 points to take a nine-point lead into the final stanza.

But Reno would not go away. The Bighorns clawed back in the fourth quarter, trailing by just four points with 14 seconds remaining. The Flash would manage to hold on, though, handing the Bighorns their first defeat since Jan. 9.

Mo Charlo went 8-for-8 from the charity stripe, en route to a team-high 20 points. Desmon Farmer and Majic Dorsey scored 18 points apiece for Reno.

The Flash were led by a 22-point effort from Luke Nevill. Andre Ingram grabbed nine boards, and Dontell Jefferson dished out nine assists for Utah.
