At a Glance: This afternoon, the Bighorns look for their 2nd-straight victory, 6th in their last 7 games and 5th in 7 tries this season against the Utah Flash...Reno has topped 100 points in 5-straight games and scored 104 in back-to-back contests...last night's victory improved the Bighorns to 5-7 in the month of January...Reno has won 2-straight on its home floor...the Bighorns enter today's game with a 2-4 (.333) record when playing during the day.

All-Time Series: Today's titanic struggle marks the 13th all-time meeting between the Bighorns and Drew Sellers' Utah Flash...the all-time series is tied, 6-6...Reno has taken 4-of-6 against the Flash this season...tonight's game marks the 7th of 10 scheduled matchups between the 2 teams...the 10 games against Utah are the most the Bighorns will play against any other opponent...the 2 teams square-off 6 times in the month of January alone...Reno is 4-1 all-time against Utah in the Reno Events Center.

Welcome to the Silver State: **G Will Blalock**, **G DeWitt Scott** and **G D.J. Strawberry** made their Bighorns debuts in last night's game...Blalock earned the start, finishing with 9 points, 8 assists, 2 steals and a block in 37 minutes of play...Blalock was acquired by Reno on Thursday in exchange for G Russell Robinson...Scott was 4-for-4 from the floor, including 2 3-pointers on his way to 10 points...Strawberry scored 7 points with 5 boards and 5 assists in 27 minutes off the bench...Scott and Strawberry were acquired by Reno on Saturday morning as free agents.

Double it Doug: **F Doug Thomas** registered a double-double last night with 11 points and 10 rebounds...marked his 3rd double-double of the season and 3rd in his last 5 outings...has scored in double figures 10 times this season, and in 4 of his last 5 games...has pulled down double-digit rebounds 4 times this season and 4 times in his last 6 games...has earned the start in 8-straight games, after coming off the bench in 13-straight to begin his tenure with the Bighorns...Reno is 5-3 (.625) with Thomas in the starting lineup...the Bighorns are 5-8 (.385) when Thomas comes off the bench.

Home Cookin': Today's game is Reno's 2nd home game since 1/12, and only its 3rd home game in the last 27 days...the Bighorns are currently 5-4 at home, 5-7 on the road and 0-2 on a neutral floor...after this weekend's games, Reno hits the road again, playing 8 of its next 10 games away from Reno...12 of Reno's final 16 games will be played at home (2/27-4/3)...**G Desmon Farmer** averages 27.4 ppg at home (23.1 ppg on the road)...as a team, the Bighorns score 104.4 ppg at home, compared with 102.8 ppg on the road.

Biggest Little Notes in the World: Last night's game marked the 1st in franchise history that didn't feature G Russell Robinson, who was traded earlier this week...last night's attendance (2,856) was the highest total of the season...the Bighorns celebrated Breast Cancer Awareness Night during yesterday's game...pink and white Bighorns t-shirts were sold, with proceeds benefiting Susan G. Komen for the Cure.

RENO, Nev.—Doug Thomas recorded a double-double and added four blocked shots Saturday night, piloting the Reno Bighorns to a 104-101 victory over the Utah Flash in the Reno Events Center.

A game that featured 10 ties and 20 lead changes fell Reno's way, marking the Bighorns' fifth win in their last six games.

The Flash (14-13) led by as many as 12 in the early-going, and Utah took a two-point lead into intermission. Reno (10-13) would come firing back, though, taking the lead for good with just more than nine minutes left to play in the final period.

Thomas finished with 11 points and 10 boards for the Bighorns. Desmon Farmer led all scorers with 27, while Yaroslav Korolev kicked-in 16 points off the bench for Reno.
