Beginning in 1957, the draft is recorded round-by-round. To enable teams to take advantage of the regional popularity of college stars, they were given the option of forfeiting their first-round pick and instead selecting, before the start of the draft, a player from the franchise's immediate geographical area. These "territorial picks," as they were known, are not factored in to the overall selection count of the draft. The territorial option was in effect through 1965.
